This FO updates the list of countries currently infested with T. absoluta by adding Albania, Greece, Netherlands, Portugal, Switzerland, and Tunisia. Of those countries, only Greece, Netherlands, and Portugal are currently authorized to export tomatoes to the United States. Pursuant to this FO, APHIS will require that shipments of tomato fruit from affected countries meet additional import requirements to prevent the introduction and establishment of T. absoluta. In addition, APHIS will prohibit the entry of plants for planting of Solanum spp., Datura spp. and Nicotiana spp., which are also hosts of T. absoluta, from affected countries pending the completion of a Pest Risk Analysis (PRA) and the implementation of appropriate mitigation measures. This FO supersedes all previous Federal Orders relating to requirements for importing hosts of T. absoluta from countries that are considered infested with the pest.
